NATIONAL

- 1. Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) has secured the top position in the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2024, reaffirming its status as India's premier academic institution.
- 2. Gopi Thotakura is making history as the first Indian pilot to venture into space as a tourist, joining Blue Origin's NS-25 mission.
- **3.** Adani Green Energy Limited, an Adani Group company, is building the world's largest renewable energy park in Khavda, Kutch district of Gujarat.
- 4. Prime Minister Narendra Modi is poised to make history as the first Indian Prime Minister since Indira Gandhi to grace the cover of Newsweek.
- 5. India and Mauritius recently signed an amendment to their Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement (DTAA) on March 7, 2024.

INTERNATIONAL

- 1. Israel deployed its ship-mounted defense system, the C-Dome, for the first time against a suspicious aerial target near the southern city of Eilat.
- 2. Lindy Cameron, a distinguished Oxford University alumna and former CEO of the UK's National Cyber Security Centre, has been appointed as the first woman high commissioner to India.
- **3.** Jagjit Pavadia Re-elected to International Narcotics Control Board. India has been elected to several key bodies at the United Nations.
- 4. World Cybercrime Index Unveiled: Russia and Ukraine Top List.
- 5. Singapore Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong to Step Down, Hands Over Power to Deputy Lawrence Wong.
- 6. Kuwait's Emir has appointed Sheikh Ahmad Abdullah Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah as the new Prime Minister following the resignation of Sheikh Mohammed Sabah Al-Salem Al-Sabah.

SCIENCE & DEFENCE

- 1. President Joe Biden and Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida revealed that Japanese astronauts will join future NASA lunar missions as part of the Artemis program.
- Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology Jodhpur (IIT Jodhpur) have unveiled a groundbreaking nano-sensor designed to swiftly detect Cytokines, vital proteins regulating various cellular functions.
- 3. Russia successfully tested its Angara-A5 space rocket for the first time on April 11, 2024.

- 1. Moody's Analytics projects a modest uptick in India's economic growth for 2024, estimating a 6.1% expansion, slightly higher than the 6% projected earlier in March.
- 2. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has revised India's GDP growth forecast for 2024-25 upwards by 30 basis points to 6.8%, citing strong domestic demand.
