- The Indian government has approved the construction of a new major port at Vadhavan in the Dahanu taluka of Palghar district, Maharashtra. This project, aligned with the PM Gatishakti programme, aims to boost India's foreign trade capabilities and local economy. The Union Cabinet, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, sanctioned this on June 19, 2024.
- The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi approved the proposal of Airports Authority of India (AAI) for development of Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport, Varanasi with an outlay of Rs 2,870 crore. It includes Construction of New Terminal Building, Apron Extension, Runway Extension, Parallel Taxi Track & Allied works.
- 3. S. Tripathy Appointed as the First Director of UVCE. On this significant day for higher education in Karnataka, the State government has made a crucial appointment that marks a new era for the University of Visvesvaraya College of Engineering (UVCE). This appointment represents an important step in the institution's history and development.
- 4. UNHCR Welcomes Theo James as New Goodwill Ambassador. On this significant day for global humanitarian efforts, the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) proudly announces the appointment of British actor Theo James as its newest Goodwill Ambassador. This appointment marks a crucial step in amplifying the voices of displaced people around the world.

5. As Global Wind Day(June 17) is celebrated across the world. GWEC India has announced that Mr Girish Tanti, Vice-Chairman of Suzlon Group, has been appointed as the Chairman. - 6. Chief of Defence Staff Gen Anil Chauhan released the Joint Doctrine for Cyberspace Operations during the Chiefs of Staff Committee (COSC) meeting held on June 18, 2024, in New Delhi. The Joint Doctrine is a keystone publication that will guide Commanders in conducting Cyberspace Operations in today's complex military operating environment.
- 7. In a bid to enhance road safety, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) Delhi, a technical university established by the Government of National Capital Territory (NCT). This collaboration aims to leverage Artificial Intelligence (AI) to improve the availability and condition of road signs on National Highways, covering approximately 25,000 kilometers.
- SabPaisa (SRS Live Technologies Private Limited), a payment solutions provider, has announced that the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted final approval to operate as a Payment Aggregator (PA) under the Payments and Settlement Systems Act of 2007.
- 9. According to the Global Energy Transition Index released by the World Economic Forum (WEF) on 19 June 2024, India has been ranked 63rd out of 120 countries, improving three ranks from last year's 67th position. Sweden has again topped the Index, reflecting its continued leadership in energy transition. The WEF highlighted India's significant advancements in energy equity, security, and sustainability.
- 10. Pat Cummins, the fast bowler, spearheaded the bowling attack by claiming a hat-trick, while David Warner's unbeaten fifty guaranteed a smooth chase as Australia comfortably defeated Bangladesh in their 'Super 8s' Group 1 encounter of the T20 World Cup. The match, held in Antigua on June 21, was under the threat of rain that disrupted proceedings twice.
- **11. International Yoga Day is a worldwide celebration of yoga**, an ancient Indian practice

that promotes physical, mental, and spiritual well-being. **Observed annually on June 21st**, this special day brings together millions of people across the globe for yoga classes, workshops, and talks. From serene mountain retreats to bustling city squares, people unite in their pursuit of holistic health and inner peace. This year's theme, **"Yoga for Self and Society,"** highlights the transformative power of yoga at both personal and community levels.

- 12. International Day of the Celebration of the Solstice 2024. The summer solstice is a natural phenomenon that occurs when the Earth's axis is most tilted towards the sun. It marks the:
 - Longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere (usually June 20th or 21st)
 - Shortest day of the year in the Southern Hemisphere (usually December 21st or 22nd)
 - This celestial event has captivated cultures worldwide for millennia, inspiring celebrations and traditions.
- 13. World Music Day, also known as 'Fête de la Musique', is an annual global celebration held in June to promote music and its universal language. On this special day, musicians from around the world perform in public spaces, sharing their talents and passion for music. The day's purpose is to provide a platform for both professional and amateur artists to express themselves through music. The inspiring tagline "Faites de la musique" (Make music) encapsulates the spirit of this event.
- 14. Former Indian pacer David Johnson has passed away at the age of 52. Johnson tragically fell from the balcony of his fourthfloor apartment in Bengaluru, leaving the cricket community in mourning.
- **15.** The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued an advisory circular titled 'Gender Equality in the Civil Aviation aimed at Sector' increasing women's representation in aviation to 25% by 2025. This initiative aligns with the gender equality principles enshrined in the Indian Constitution the International Civil Aviation and Organisation's (ICAO) vision for equal opportunities in aviation.

- 16. Indian funds in Swiss banks have plummeted by 70% in 2023, reaching a four-year low of 1.04 billion Swiss Francs (₹9,771 crore), according to the Swiss National Bank (SNB). This marks a significant decline after a peak in 2021 and is attributed to decreases in bonds, securities, and other financial instruments.
- 17. On June 19, the upper house of the Tajikistan parliament, Majlisi Milli, passed a law prohibiting "alien garments," which primarily targets the hijab and other traditional Islamic clothing. The lower chamber, Majlisi Namoyandagon, had passed the bill on May 8. This move has sparked debate among Tajikistan's predominantly Muslim population in the tightly governed ex-Soviet republic.
- 18. The Hemis Festival, a vibrant celebration of Tibetan Buddhism, takes place annually in Ladakh, India. In 2024, this important cultural event will be held on June 16th and 17th. The Hemis Festival, also known as Hemis Tsechu, commemorates the birth anniversary of Guru Padmasambhava, a revered figure in Tibetan Buddhism. This two-day celebration brings the Hemis Monastery, Ladakh's largest Buddhist monastery, to life with color, music, and spiritual energy.
- 19. Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL), a leading Indian defense electronics company, has announced a significant change in its top leadership. Manoj Jain has been appointed as the new Chairman and Managing Director of the company.
- 20. The government (on 20 June) has appointed Atul Kumar Chaudhary, as the new Secretary, the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), the position which was lying vacant after the superannuation of V Raghunandan on May 31.
- 21. President Appoints Bhartruhari Mahtab As Pro-Tem Speaker Of Lok Sabha. In a significant development, Bhartruhari Mahtab, a seventerm Lok Sabha member, has been appointed as the pro tem Speaker of the Lower House. The announcement was made by Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju on June 20.

- 22. Rear Admiral Nelson D'Souza has taken over as Commandant of Military Institute of Technology (MILIT), Pune from Air Vice Marshal Vivek Blouria. An accomplished alumnus of the Defence Services Staff College, Wellington and Naval War College, Goa, Rear Admiral D'Souza has served in numerous key positions within the Indian Navy since his commissioning in March 1991.
- 23. Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank (KVGB), a regional rural bank sponsored by Canara Bank, has been honoured with a national award by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) for significant enrolment under the Atal Pension Yojana (APY).
- 24. The government monetised assets worth ₹1.56 lakh crore under the National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP) in the financial year 2023-24, falling short of the target of ₹1.8 lakh crore. This performance represents approximately 159% of the achievement in 2021-22. The NMP aims to unlock the value of brownfield infrastructure assets, with a total monetisation potential estimated at ₹6 lakh crore over a four-year period from FY22 to FY25.



- 25. India Ranks Third in Global Domestic Airline Market. India has achieved significant milestones in its domestic aviation sector over the past decade, emerging as the world's thirdlargest market for domestic airlines by April 2024. This marks a remarkable ascent from its fifth position ten years ago, driven by robust growth and strategic developments under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership.
- 26. International Widow's Day 2024: Observed annually on 23 June, International Widow's Day (IWD) is a significant occasion dedicated to raising awareness about the plight of widows worldwide and advocating for their rights and well-being.
- 27. Every year on June 23rd, the world celebrates United Nations Public Service Day. This special day highlights the importance of public service and recognizes the hard work of public servants globally.
- 28. Every year on June 21st, the world celebrates World Hydrography Day. This important day, organized by the International Hydrographic Organisation (IHO), aims to raise awareness about hydrography and its crucial role in understanding our seas and oceans. The theme for World Hydrography Day 2024 is: "Hydrographic Information – Enhancing Safety, Efficiency and Sustainability in Marine Activities".
- 29. The 53rd GST Council met under the Chairpersonship of Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman in New Delhi. The meeting was attended by key officials, including Union Minister of State for Finance Shri Pankaj Chaudhary, Chief Ministers of Goa and Meghalaya, Deputy Chief Ministers of Bihar, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, and Odisha, Finance Ministers of States & UTs (with legislature), and senior officers of the Ministry of Finance & States/ UTs.
- 30. A meeting between the two delegations in the national capital on June 22, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that India will start an e-medical visa facility for Bangladeshi nationals. For those who are coming to India for medical treatment, India will open a new

consulate in Rangpur, Bangladesh, to facilitate services for people in the northwest region of the country.

- 31. The Centre has introduced a stringent antipaper leak law amid controversies surrounding the NEET and UGC-NET exams. The law, which came into force on June 21, 2024, imposes severe penalties, including up to 10 years of imprisonment and a fine of Rs 1 crore, to curb malpractices in competitive examinations.
- 32. On June 23, 2024, Kozhikode made history by becoming the first UNESCO City of Literature in India. This prestigious recognition highlights the city's rich literary heritage and cultural significance.
- 33. Telugu Desam Party's Narsipatnam MLA C. Ayyanna Patrudu was elected unanimously as the Speaker of the 16th Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly on June 22, 2024. Mr. Ayyanna Patrudu's election was a mere formality as no other MLA filed a nomination for the Speaker's post to challenge him.
- 34. The Director General of the National Testing Agency, Subodh Kumar Singh, was removed from the post on June 22, amid controversy over irregularities in exams. Subodh Kumar Singh's services were put on a "compulsory wait" in the Department of Personnel and Training, the government said in a letter. India Trade Promotion Organisation Chairman and MD Pradeep Singh Kharola was assigned additional charge of NTA DG till the appointment of a regular incumbent or until further orders.
- 35. According to the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), foreign direct investment (FDI) to India in 2023 decreased by 43% compared to 2022, dropping India's rank to 15th among global FDI recipients. This decline mirrors a global trend where overall FDI fell by 2%.
- 36. In a thrilling display of skill and strategy, Max Verstappen secured victory at the Spanish Grand Prix on Sunday, further solidifying his position atop the Formula 1 drivers championship.

- 37. World Rainforest Day is celebrated annually on June 22nd. It aims to raise awareness about the importance of rainforests and encourage their protection and conservation. The day was first observed in 2017 by the Rainforest Partnership. The theme for World Rainforest Day 2024 is "Empowering the World in Defense of Our Rainforests."
- 38. International Olympic Day is celebrated on June 23rd every year. It marks the founding of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) in 1894. This day celebrates the Olympic spirit and encourages people to get involved in sports. The theme for International Olympic Day 2024 is "Let's Move and Celebrate." This theme encourages everyone to be active and enjoy the joy of movement.
- 39. The International Day of Women in Diplomacy, observed annually on June 24th, recognizes the crucial role of women in shaping international relations and promoting peace.
- 40. Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Shri Jagat Prakash Nadda launched the National STOP Diarrhoea Campaign 2024, on June 24. He was joined by Smt. Anupriya Patel and Shri Jadhav Patraprao Ganpatrao, Union Ministers of State for Health and Family Welfare. The dignitaries also released IEC materials like logo, posters, radio spots and audio visuals for the campaign and distributed oral rehydration salts (ORS) and zinc tablets to children on the occasion.
- **41.** The government has appointed **Girija Subramanian as chairman and managing director (CMD)** of New India Assurance, the largest general insurer in India. She will hold this position from June 19, 2024, until she attains the age of superannuation or until further orders.
- 42. On June 22, 2024, a significant literary event took place at Raj Bhavan Mumbai, highlighting the rich maritime heritage of the Mumbai region. The Governor of Maharashtra, Shri Ramesh Bais, released a book titled 'Gateways to the Sea: Historic Ports and Docks of Mumbai Region', shedding light on the area's ancient and modern maritime history.

- **43.** Chief Minister Mohan Yadav said the centre of **'Bharatiya Gyan Parampara'** will be opened in every PM College of Excellence and necessary arrangements will be made in this regard. The PM College of Excellence is going to get started from July 1 in all the 55 districts of Madhya Pradesh.
- 44. Private sector general insurer HDFC ERGO General Insurance announced the appointment of Anuj Tyagi as its new Managing Director (MD) and Chief Executive Officer (CEO), effective July 1, 2024. Tyagi, who has been with the company since 2008 and currently serves as Deputy MD, will succeed Ritesh Kumar, the MD & CEO since 2008. This leadership transition has received all necessary regulatory approvals.
- **45.** In a significant financial gesture, **the State Bank of India (SBI)** has distributed a dividend of **Rs 6,959 crore** to the Indian government for the financial year 2023-24. This marks an increase from the previous year's dividend of Rs 11.30 per share to Rs 13.70 per share. The dividend cheque was presented by SBI Chairman Dinesh Kumar Khara to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, in the presence of **Financial Services Secretary Vivek Joshi**. SBI reported a record consolidated net profit of Rs 67,085 crore for the year, up from Rs 55,648 crore the previous year.
- 46. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced a significant update to its 'Database on Indian Economy' (DBIE) portal, effective immediately. The portal's domain address will now be accessed through https://data.rbi.org.in, consolidating its services and ensuring seamless access for users. Previously used URLs, such as https://dbie.rbi.org.in and https://cimsdbie.rbi.org.in , will automatically redirect to the new address.
- **47. S&P Global Ratings** has maintained its GDP growth forecast for India at **6.8% for FY25**, citing high interest rates and reduced fiscal stimulus as factors tempering demand in non-agricultural sectors. The projection for FY26 and FY27 stands at 6.9% and 7%, respectively.

- 48. In Ladakh, as a tribute to the heroes of the Kargil War, the Indian Army has opened the Khalubar War Memorial to tourists. This opening ceremony was part of the 'Forever in Operations' Division's Pre-Kargil Vijay Diwas celebrations as this year, the country will celebrate the 25th anniversary of Kargil Vijay Diwas on 26 July. Located in the renowned Aryan Valley this memorial commemorates the bravery and sacrifices of soldiers who fought to reclaim the valley during the war.
- 49. Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Earth Sciences, MoS PMO, Department of Atomic Energy, Department of Space, Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions Dr. Jitendra Singh on June 24, launched "One Week One Theme" (OWOT) campaign showcasing recent success stories of India in different streams of science and technology.

50. The Archery World Cup 2024 Stage 3 in Antalya, Turkey concluded on June 23, 2024, with Indian archers showcasing their exceptional skills and bringing home multiple medals. This prestigious event, organized by World Archery from June 18-23, 2024, saw India's team finish with an impressive tally of four medals – one gold, one silver, and two bronze.

- **51. Every year on June 25th**, we celebrate the **International Day of the Seafarer**. This special day was created by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) in 2010 to recognize the important role seafarers play in our daily lives and the global economy.
- 52. Srinagar has become the fourth Indian city to be recognised as a 'World Craft City' by the World Craft Council (WCC). Three years after it was designated as part of the UNESCO Creative City Network (UCCN) for crafts and folk arts.
- 53. Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) president and Union Minister Jagat Prakash Nadda has been named Leader of the House in the Rajya Sabha. Mr. Nadda replaces Union Minister Piyush Goyal, who recently won the Lok Sabha election and took oath on June 24, as a member of the Lower House of Parliament.
- 54. The 64th International Sugar Organisation (ISO) Council meeting commenced on 25th June 2024 at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi, bringing together delegates from over 30 countries and representatives of various international organizations. The meeting, held from 25-27 June 2024, aims to discuss issues related to the sugar industry and biofuels sectors.
- 55. Indian wrestlers ended their campaign in the Under-17 Asian Wrestling Championship 2024 with an impressive tally of 11 medals, including four gold, two silver, and five bronze. The event was held in Amman, Jordan, from 22-24 June 2024. Following the U-17 competition, the U-23 championship commenced.
- 56. Smriti Mandhana became the first Indian woman to record two consecutive ODI hundreds during the second ODI against South Africa at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru on June 19. She scripted history on June 23, after she registered the record for the most runs by an Indian woman in a bilateral One-Day International series.
- 57. Every year on June 26th, people around the world come together to observe the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, also known as World Drug

Day. This important day was established by the United Nations in 1987 to raise awareness about the dangers of drug abuse and to encourage cooperation in creating a world free from this problem.

- 58. Every year on June 26th, the world observes the International Day in Support of Victims of Torture. This important day was established by the United Nations in 1997 to raise awareness about the terrible practice of torture and to show support for those who have suffered from it.
- 59. According to the Union Ministry of Education, the Union Territory of Ladakh has achieved full functional literacy under the ULLAS-Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram. Ladakh now boasts over 97 percent literacy. Lieutenant Governor Dr. B.D Mishra shared this milestone on June 25, 2024, at a function in Sindhu Sanskritik Kendra (SSK), Leh.
- 60. Paraguay has officially become the 100th full member of the International Solar Alliance (ISA), marking a significant milestone in global solar energy cooperation. The Ambassador of Paraguay, H.E. Mr. Fleming Raul Duarte, handed over the Instrument of Ratification during a meeting in New Delhi with Shri Abhishek Singh, Joint Secretary (ED & MER) and Head of Depository.
- 61. The Madhya Pradesh cabinet, led by Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, decided on June 25, 2024, that state ministers will now be responsible for paying income tax on their salaries and allowances out of their own pockets. This marks a significant change from a 1972 rule under which the state government bore the tax burden. This decision was approved unanimously during a cabinet meeting held in Bhopal.
- 62. Mrs. Aksha Mohit Kamboj has been appointed as the Vice President of the India Bullion Jewellers Association (IBJA), effective from June 22, 2024. This historic appointment marks her as the first woman to hold this prestigious position in the gold and jewellery sector. Mrs. Kamboj, known for her leadership as Executive Chairperson of Aspect Global Ventures Pvt Ltd and as a co-owner of the Tiigers of Kolkata

cricket team, brings extensive experience and a commitment to industry excellence.

- 63. In a significant development for global security, NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organization) has announced the appointment of Mark Rutte, the outgoing Dutch Prime Minister, as its next Secretary General. This decision marks an important milestone for the 75-year-old alliance as it faces critical challenges in the coming years.
- 64. ICICI Bank's market capitalisation(m-cap) on June 25 crossed the \$100-billion mark for the first time, becoming only the sixth company to do so. The private sector lender joins the likes of Reliance Industries, Tata Consultancy Services, HDFC Bank, and Bharti Airtel. The four other domestically listed companies with a market value of more than \$100 billion.
- 65. Gross domestic product (GDP) growth during 2024-25 (FY25) may turn out to be higher than 7 per cent and even close to 7.5 per cent, with high frequency indicators showing resilience amid growth dynamism in the Indian economy. The monthly economic review released by the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCEAR).
- 66. At its Golden Jubilee celebration, Central Electronics Limited (CEL) was honored with "Mini RATNA" status (Category-1) by Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh. This recognition underscores CEL's transformation from a loss-making PSU to a profitable entity, achieving a net profit of approximately Rs 58 crore and consistently paying dividends to the Government of India for three consecutive years.
- 67. Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE) Ltd. has been honoured with the "Sustainable Governance Champion Award" at the Outlook Planet Sustainability Summit & Awards 2024. This recognition highlights GRSE's unwavering commitment to sustainable practices and governance excellence.
- 68. India's defence exports to the United States (US) has grown to account for over 50 per cent of the total exports, exceeding \$2.8 billion during the last 5 years, said Ranjana Khanna,

Director General and CEO – American Chamber of Commerce in India (Amcham).

- 69. The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) handed over the Medium Range-Microwave Obscurant Chaff Rocket (MR-MOCR) to the Indian Navy in a ceremony held in New Delhi. This rocket creates a microwave obscurant cloud in space, forming an effective shield against threats with radio frequency seekers.
- 70. David Warner Retires From International Cricket. The cricketing world bid farewell to one of its most dynamic players as David Warner officially retired from international cricket. Warner's illustrious 15-year career with the Australian national team came to an end following Australia's elimination from the T20 World Cup in the Super Eight phase.
- 71. Every year on June 27, the world celebrates Micro-, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSME) Day. This important observance highlights the crucial role these businesses play in our economies and communities. The 2024 theme focuses on "Leveraging Power and Resilience of Micro-, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSMEs) to Accelerate Sustainable Development and Eradicate Poverty in Times of Multiple Crises". This theme recognizes the potential of MSMEs to drive progress towards the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
