1. In a significant move to bolster India's position in the global fashion industry, Union Minister of Textiles, Shri Giriraj Singh, unveiled the **'VisionNxt Fashion Forecasting Initiative'** developed by the **National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT)**. This launch event, which also saw the introduction of a bilingual web portal and the India-specific Fashion Trend Book **'Paridhi 24x25'**, marks a pivotal moment in India's fashion and textile sector.
2. In a significant development for **India's fintech landscape, Paysharp, an emerging startup from Tamil Nadu, has achieved a major milestone.** On August 30, 2024, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) granted Paysharp its final authorization, cementing the company's position in India's dynamic payment system ecosystem.
3. On September 4-5, 2024, a significant event took place in the military landscape of India. The first **Joint Commander's Conference of the Armed Forces was held in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh**, marking a new era in the coordination and integration of India's military forces. This two-day conference, presided over by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, brought together top military brass to discuss crucial issues facing the armed forces and to strategize on the future of India's defense capabilities.
4. In a significant move towards enhancing maritime security and cooperation in Asia, **the Indian Coast Guard participated in the 20th Heads of Asian Coast Guard Agencies Meeting (HACGAM) held in Incheon, South Korea.** This important gathering, which took place from September 2-6, 2024, brought together coast guard agencies from across Asia to discuss crucial maritime issues and strengthen collaborative efforts.
5. Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to launch a groundbreaking initiative called **"Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari"** in Surat, Gujarat. This initiative represents a significant step towards enhancing community involvement in water conservation efforts across India. The launch aligns with the ongoing **"Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain"** campaign, reinforcing the Prime Minister's vision of collaborative water management to ensure long-term water security for the nation.
6. In a significant move towards enhancing international cooperation in public sector auditing, the **Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the UAE Accountability Authority.** This agreement marks a new chapter in the bilateral relations between India and the United Arab Emirates, focusing on strengthening their respective audit institutions and promoting good governance.

7. **Star Health and Allied Insurance**, a prominent health insurance provider in India, has taken a groundbreaking step towards inclusivity by introducing an insurance policy in Braille. This initiative marks a significant milestone in empowering visually impaired individuals, allowing them to access crucial health insurance information independently.
8. In a significant development for India's insurance sector, **Kotak General Insurance has undergone a transformative rebranding, emerging as Zurich Kotak General Insurance**. This change comes on the heels of a major acquisition that sees the global insurance giant, **Zurich Insurance Group, taking a commanding 70% stake in the company**. This move not only reshapes the competitive landscape of India's general insurance market but also signals a new chapter in foreign investment in the country's financial services sector.
9. In a significant development for the Indian financial markets, **Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL)** has announced a crucial step in its leadership transition. The company has received the green light from the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for the appointment of Nehal Vora as its Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer (MD & CEO). This approval, conveyed through a SEBI letter dated August 29, 2024, marks a pivotal moment in CDSL's corporate governance and strategic direction.
10. The release of the **TIME100 Most Influential People in AI 2024 List** has once again highlighted India's significant contributions to the rapidly evolving field of artificial intelligence. This prestigious list, unveiled on Thursday, features an impressive array of leaders, innovators, and thinkers of Indian origin or with strong

ties to India, underscoring the country's growing prominence in shaping the global AI landscape.

11. In a landmark moment for Indian sports, **Kapil Parmar** has etched his name in the annals of Paralympic history by securing India's first-ever medal in judo at the Paralympic Games. **Parmar's bronze medal victory in the men's 60kg (J1) category** marks a significant milestone in the country's para-sports journey.
12. In celebration of the birth anniversary of **Hockey Legend Major Dhyhan Chand** and in alignment with the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports' National Sports Day 2024, the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting organized "**Khel Utsav 2024**" from August 27 to August 30, 2024. The event took place at Major Dhyhan Chand Stadium and Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi.

13. **Super Typhoon Yagi**, the most powerful storm to hit Asia in over a decade, has caused significant disruption across Southeast Asia. After devastating the northern Philippines, the typhoon made landfall in southern China's Hainan province, leading to mass evacuations and widespread damage. Yagi is expected to continue its path towards Vietnam and Laos, impacting northern regions with severe weather conditions.
14. **The 21st edition of Varuna (Varuna-23) naval exercise between the Indian and French Navies was held in two phases in 2023.** India-France Bilateral Naval Exercise Varuna is a key strategic exercise, initiated in 1993 and named 'Varuna' in 2001. Phase II took place in the Arabian Sea and involved joint operations using guided missile frigates, tankers, Maritime Patrol Aircraft, and helicopters. The exercise aimed to enhance warfighting skills, improve interoperability, and promote security in the region. The first phase occurred from January 16-20, 2023, off India's Western Seaboard.
15. **The 5th Defence Cooperation Dialogue between India and the Maldives was held in New Delhi on September 6, 2024.** The Indian delegation was led by Defence Secretary Shri Giridhar Aramane, while the Maldivian delegation was headed by General Ibrahim Hilmy, Chief of Defence Force, Maldives National Defence Force. The meeting provided a platform to advance bilateral defence cooperation, focusing on the implementation of ongoing projects and fostering stability in the Indian Ocean region.
16. A successful test launch of the **Agni-4 Intermediate Range Ballistic Missile (IRBM)** was carried out from the **Integrated Test Range in Chandipur, Odisha, on September 6, 2024.** The missile, developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), validated all operational and technical parameters during the test.
17. As a precursor to **International Literacy Day 2024**, the **Ministry of Education, Government of India**, will host an International Conference titled "**Spectrum of Literacy**" on September 7, 2024. This virtual conference will be organized by CIET, NCERT, New Delhi, and will bring together global and national experts, educators, policymakers, and literacy advocates to explore the multifaceted dimensions of literacy in today's world.
18. In a stunning display of perseverance and skill, **India's Hokato Hotozhe Sema has clinched the bronze medal in the men's shot put F57 class at the Paris 2024 Paralympics.** This achievement not only marks a personal milestone for Sema but also contributes to India's growing success in para-athletics on the global stage.
19. **Indian para-athlete Praveen Kumar** has etched his name in the annals of Paralympic history with his spectacular gold medal win in the men's high jump **T64 final at the Paris Paralympics 2024.** This victory not only marks a personal milestone for Kumar but also adds to India's growing success in para-athletics on the global stage.
20. **On September 7, the world observes the International Day of Police Cooperation**, recognizing the crucial role of law enforcement in global security. This day highlights the importance of collaboration among police forces worldwide and emphasizes the need for a comprehensive framework to ensure police integrity, accountability, and oversight.
21. Recognizing the significance of DMD as one of the most common pediatric genetic rare diseases, the **United Nations General Assembly has designated September 7th**



**as World Duchenne Awareness Day.** This observance will be officially recognized as a United Nations Day starting in 2024. Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD) is a rare genetic disorder characterized by progressive muscle degeneration and weakness. This condition primarily affects males due to its X-chromosome-linked nature. Named after **Dr. Duchenne de Boulogne**, who first described the disease in detail in the 1860s, DMD continues to be a focus of medical research and advocacy efforts worldwide.

22. **Air pollution** stands as the most significant environmental health risk of our time, with far-reaching consequences for human health, climate change, economic stability, and agricultural productivity. Recognizing the urgent need for action, the United Nations has designated **September 7th as the International Day of Clean Air** for blue skies. This observance serves as a global call to action, urging governments, corporations, civil society, and individuals to Invest in **#CleanAirNow**.
23. **Since 1967, International Literacy Day (ILD) has been observed annually on September 8th across the globe.** This day serves as a crucial reminder to policymakers, practitioners, and the public about the critical importance of literacy in creating a more literate, just, peaceful, and sustainable society. The observance underscores the ongoing global commitment to fostering literacy as a fundamental human right and a cornerstone of personal and societal development.
24. The **first Saturday of September International Vulture Awareness Day (IVAD)**, an annual event dedicated to raising awareness about the world's most imperilled group of birds. This initiative, which began in South Africa and the United Kingdom, has been observed since September 2009. Vultures, often misunderstood and unfairly maligned, play a crucial role in maintaining ecological balance. Despite their association with death and perceived negative traits, these birds are, in fact, the unsung heroes of the natural world. As the only land-dwelling obligate scavengers, vultures provide essential ecological services that benefit both the environment and human society.
25. Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, **Shri Amit Shah**, presided over a significant event in Mumbai, Maharashtra, marking the release of the **'200 Not Out'** documentary chronicling the illustrious journey of Mumbai Samachar, Asia's oldest newspaper. The ceremony, attended by dignitaries including Maharashtra Chief Minister Shri Eknath Shinde, highlighted the newspaper's enduring legacy and its role in shaping India's journalistic landscape.
26. **French President Emmanuel Macron** has made a significant political decision by appointing **Michel Barnier**, the former EU Brexit negotiator, as France's new Prime Minister on September 5, 2024. This appointment comes after an extended period of political uncertainty and marks a crucial moment in France's ongoing efforts to form a stable government.
27. **Algerian President Abdelmadjid Tebboune** has been re-elected for a second term with 95% of the vote, according to the country's electoral authority, **ANIE**. The official results indicate that Tebboune received 94.65% of the vote, while his opponents, Abdelaali Hassani Cherif and Youcef Aouchiche, garnered 3% and 2% respectively. Voter turnout was reported at 48%, with more than 24 million Algerians registered to vote.
28. **Israel's Tower Semiconductor and India's Adani Group are set to invest 839.47 billion rupees (\$10 billion)** in a

semiconductor manufacturing project in Maharashtra. The initiative highlights India's push to become a global hub for chip production, despite previous challenges such as Foxconn's withdrawal from a \$19.5 billion joint venture with Vedanta and stalled plans by ISMC to invest \$3 billion.

29. The Indian government has appointed **Tuhin Kanta Pandey, a 1987-batch IAS officer from the Odisha cadre, as the new Finance Secretary.** This decision was made on September 7, 2024, following the appointment of T.V. Somanathan as the Cabinet Secretary, which created a vacancy for the finance role. Pandey, who previously served as the Secretary of the Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM), will now oversee India's financial policies and decisions.
30. **Arun Goel** has been appointed as India's next **Ambassador to Croatia**, succeeding Raj Kumar Srivastava. The Ministry of External Affairs announced his new role on September 7, 2024. Goel, a retired 1985-batch IAS officer from the Punjab cadre, previously served as the Election Commissioner of India from November 21, 2022, to March 9, 2024.
31. **Dr. Vinay Goyal has officially assumed the role of State Mission Director for the National Health Mission (NHM).** He succeeds K. Jeevan Babu, who has moved to the Kerala Water Authority as Managing Director. Dr. Goyal, an IAS officer of the 2016 batch, also takes charge as Director of the Kerala State IT Mission and Project Director at eHealth Kerala. In his new roles, he aims to advance Kerala's digital and health infrastructure.
32. The State Bank of India (SBI) Foundation has unveiled the third edition of its flagship initiative, the **SBI Asha Scholarship Programme.** This ambitious program aims to support 10,000 talented students from underprivileged backgrounds across India, offering substantial financial assistance to help them pursue their educational dreams.
33. **On September 8, 2024, a landmark moment in Asian sports history unfolded as Randhir Singh, a veteran sports administrator, was elected as the president of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA).** This momentous event took place during the **44th General Assembly** of the continental body in New Delhi, marking the first time an Indian has ascended to this prestigious position.
34. **The International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies (Swachh Vayu Diwas) was observed on 7th September 2024 in Jaipur.** Union Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Bhupender Yadav, and Rajasthan Chief Minister, Bhajan Lal Sharma, led the event. Key dignitaries included Rajasthan's Minister of State for Environment, Sanjay Sharma, and Urban Development Minister, Jhabar Singh Kharra.
35. **Moeen Ali**, the versatile England all-rounder, has officially announced his retirement from international cricket. This decision comes in the wake of his omission from the upcoming white-ball series against Australia, signalling the end of an era for English cricket.
36. **Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, India's Union Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports, announced India's bid for the 2030 Youth Olympics during his speech at the of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)44th General Assembly on September 8, 2024.** India will compete against Peru, Colombia, Mexico, Thailand, Mongolia, Russia, Ukraine, and Bosnia and Herzegovina for hosting rights. This bid is seen as a precursor to India's ambition to host the 2036 Olympics.

37. **Jannik Sinner**, the world's No. 1 tennis player, clinched his second **Grand Slam title at the U.S. Open, defeating Taylor Fritz in a thrilling final**. This victory marked a remarkable comeback for Sinner, who faced significant challenges leading up to the tournament.
38. **The 5th Observance of the UN International Day to Protect Education from Attack** is set to take place on September 9, 2024, in Doha, Qatar. This crucial event will be held at the QNCC Auditorium 3, featuring a High-Level Panel led by Her Highness Sheikha Moza bint Nasser, Chairperson of Education Above All Foundation and UN SDG Advocate
39. India's aviation sector has experienced significant growth, evolving into one of the largest and most dynamic markets in the world. With the **2nd Asia Pacific Ministerial Conference on Civil Aviation** scheduled from September 11-12, 2024, in New Delhi, India is set to reinforce its leadership in aviation. 40. **The Quality Council of India (QCI)** has provisionally approved **National Test House (NTH), Ghaziabad**, as a certification body for type certification of drones under the **Drone Rules 2021**. NTH will assess agricultural drones, including **Vimaana Aerospace Technologies' Krishiraj 1.0**, and provide low-cost certification services to support the growing drone sector in India.
41. In a solemn and significant ceremony held today at the **Office of the President, Sheetal Niwas, Ashok Raj Sigdel** was officially sworn in as the **45th Chief of the Army Staff (CoAS) of the Nepali Army**. This momentous occasion marks a new chapter in Nepal's military leadership and underscores the nation's commitment to its armed forces.
42. **Nepal has become the 101st country to join the International Solar Alliance (ISA) as a full member**. The Ministry of External Affairs said that Nepal handed over its Instrument of Ratification to the ISA in New Delhi on 9th September. The ISA is a global intergovernmental organization dedicated to advancing solar power adoption for a carbon-neutral future.
43. India has overtaken China in the **Morgan Stanley Capital International (MSCI) Emerging Markets Investable Market Index (EM IMI)** with a weightage of 22.27%, surpassing China's 21.58%. This shift reflects India's strong market performance and favorable macroeconomic conditions, contrasted with China's economic challenges.
44. **India Remains Top Source for Sri Lanka Tourism in 2024**. As Indians roam all around the world, recent data came out as Sri Lanka is also one of the top travel destinations for Indians in 2024. India maintained the top spot for Sri Lanka in the first 8 months of this year.
45. Researchers have identified a new cousin species from a ginger family called turmeric, **Genus Curcuma** at Ungma village in Mokokchung district in the state of Nagaland, this information related research paper published by the botanical survey of India.
46. **The Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC)** has announced the appointment of **RS Sharma as its Non-Executive Chairperson**. Sharma, who has previously served as the Director General and Mission Director of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), Chairman of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), and CEO of the National Health Authority, will now lead ONDC into its next phase of growth and innovation.

47. The Ministry of Steel organized the event called **“Greening Steel: Pathway to Sustainability” on 10th September** in New Delhi. In this event members from different ministries, academia, think tanks, field specialists participated to discuss the agenda of the meeting.
48. The **International Monetary Fund (IMF)** has revised its forecast **for India’s GDP growth in FY2024-25 upward to 7%, a 20** basis point increase from the previous estimate of 6.8%. This revision reflects the IMF’s updated World Economic Outlook report, driven by enhanced consumption prospects, particularly in rural areas. India’s economic growth is projected to remain robust, solidifying its position as the fastest-growing major economy among emerging markets.
49. **Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC)** and **ExxonMobil** have announced a landmark partnership to develop the world’s largest low-carbon hydrogen facility. This ambitious project, set to be located in Baytown, Texas, marks a significant milestone in the race to lead sustainable energy production and combat climate change.
50. **India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE)** took a significant step forward in their strategic partnership by **signing five groundbreaking agreements**. These deals, covering crucial areas such as **nuclear energy, fossil fuels, and food security**, were formalized during a high-level meeting between Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan and Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi in New Delhi.
51. The central government will launch the **Partnerships for Accelerated Innovation and Research (PAIR)** programme designed to elevate research capabilities in higher education institutions (HEIs) by linking top-tier research institutions with those where research capability is limited, creating a collaborative mentorship environment.
52. **IIFT Ranks No. 1 Globally for Networking in LinkedIn MBA 2024, Secures 51st Overall**. The Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT), under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, has been ranked No. 1 globally for Networking in LinkedIn’s Global MBA Ranking 2024, while securing the 51st position among the top 100 MBA programmes worldwide.
53. **The Competition Commission of India (CCI)** has cleared the proposal of India’s giant business group **Tata Motors Finance Limited** merger into the Tata Capital Limited marking a significant consolidation into Tata group financial services. The merger will be carried out through a scheme of arrangement to be submitted to the National Company Law Tribunal.
54. **India Bolsters Naval Capabilities: Launch of Mahe Class Anti-Submarine Warfare Vessels**. On September 9, 2024, the Cochin Shipyard marked a significant milestone in India’s naval defense capabilities by launching two new vessels:  
**Malpe**: The fourth ship in the Mahe Class  
**Mulki**: The fifth ship in the Mahe Class  
These Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW-SWC) vessels were launched in a ceremony held in Kochi, Kerala.
55. **The 4th Intercontinental Cup men’s** football championship concluded with a stunning victory for Syria, as they defeated the defending champions India with a decisive 3-0 score in the final round-robin match. The tournament, held from September 3 to 9, 2024, at the GMC Balayogi Gachibowli Stadium in Hyderabad, Telangana, showcased Syria’s dominance throughout the competition.
56. In a groundbreaking moment for Indian boxing, **Deepali Thapa** etched her name in



the annals of sports history by becoming the first-ever schoolgirl champion at the Asian Youth Boxing Championships held in Al Ain, UAE on Sunday. This remarkable achievement not only highlights Thapa's exceptional talent but also underscores India's rising prowess in women's boxing on the international stage.

57. 59. **The Union Cabinet** has approved the **Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana – IV (PMGSY-IV) for the financial years 2024-25 to 2028-29, with a total outlay of ₹70,125 crore**. This initiative aims to construct 62,500 kilometers of roads to connect 25,000 previously unconnected habitations, enhancing accessibility and promoting socio-economic development in remote rural areas.
60. Recent horrific incident in West Bengal hospital which shook the nation, aftermath of this case West Bengal cabinet proposes to set up a **POCSO (Protection of children from sexual offenses)** Fast track special court to fast track the cases related to these cases.
61. The governor of **Maharashtra Shri. C. P. Radhakrishnan** has announced in the event that Maharashtra state will establish the tribal university for the development of tribal students and for their better future. This university will be established in the Nashik district of Maharashtra.
62. **The National Health Authority (NHA) and IIT Kanpur** signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in the presence of Union Health Secretary Shri Apurva Chandra on 11th September. The partnership aims to revolutionize Artificial Intelligence in health research with an innovative data platform.
63. On September 11, 2024, the **President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu**, presided over a distinguished ceremony at Rashtrapati Bhavan to present the **National Florence Nightingale Awards for the year 2024**. This prestigious event recognized outstanding contributions in the field of nursing, highlighting the crucial role that nursing professionals play in the healthcare system.
64. **Switzerland crowned as best country in the world**. In a new survey which is called "**Best countries for 2024**" it is found that Switzerland was crowned as the best country in the world. Switzerland achieved this fate in the third year successively. This year India drops three positions with respect to last year to 33.
65. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated **SEMICON India 2024 at India Expo Mart in Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh, on September 11, 2024**. The three-day conference, running from September 11 to 13, showcases India's semiconductor strategy and policy with



the aim of positioning the country as a global semiconductor hub.

66. In a momentous event at **Nirvachan Sadan**, the Election Commission of India (ECI) celebrated the achievements of two remarkable Paralympic archers while simultaneously enlisting their support to inspire voters across the nation. **Ms. Sheetal Devi and Shri Rakesh Kumar**, fresh from their bronze medal victory in Archery at the Paris Summer Paralympics 2024, were honored for their sporting prowess and appointed as national icons for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).
67. **Prasanthi Ram (32)**, who was an Indian origin lecturer from the **University of Nanyang** technological University won the Singapore literature prize for English fiction for her short story -'**Nine Yard Sarees**' and it was her debut work which was published at the end of year 2023.
68. **The Union Cabinet** has extended the benefits of the **Ayushman Bharat PM Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY)** to all senior citizens aged 70 and above, irrespective of their income. Announced by Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw, the scheme will provide free treatment up to Rs 5 lakh per year, benefiting around 6 crore individuals and 4.5 crore families.
69. As India prepares to commemorate the **10th anniversary of the Swachh Bharat Mission**, the nation is gearing up for a fortnight-long campaign that aims to reinforce the importance of cleanliness in everyday life. The **Swachhata Hi Seva** campaign, an annual event since 2017, serves as a precursor to Swachh Bharat Diwas, observed on October 2nd to coincide with Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary.
70. **The Union Minister Shri Rajeev Ranjan Singh** unveiled a series of initiatives aimed at transforming India's fisheries sector. A key highlight was the launch of the **National Fisheries Development Program (NFDP)** portal, which will provide digital identities to fisheries industry workers and enterprises across the value chain.
